- **You are guaranteed a shirt, hat, and neck gaiter if you register by Wednesday, June 26th.**

Check-in, registration & Captains Social: Friday, July 19, 2024, from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM

- Only one team member should check in at the registration table to receive the team number required for weigh-in.
- The official measuring stick will be available for accurate measurement of your catch.
- Food and beverages will be provided.

Fishing Tournament: Saturday, July 20, 2024, starting at 6:00 AM

- Maximum of 5 team members per boat, including the guide, who must be a paid entry.
- Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each species: Redfish, Trout, and Flounder.
- The weigh-in opens at 1:00 PM and closes at 4:00 PM.
- Random polygraph tests will be administered.
- Food, beverages, and door prizes available (must be present to win).

Entry Fee

- \$250 per angler

Optional Team Pot

- Entry: \$200 per team
- Payout for 1st to 3rd places (30% of the Optional Team Pot goes to the CCAPI Scholarship)
- Team Pot consists of a 3-fish stringer (Redfish, Trout, Flounder).

Rules & Information:

- All team members 18 years or older who are not CCAPI members must include \$50 for their 2024 CCAPI Membership. High school and college students are exempt.
- Entry deadline is Friday, July 19, 2024, at 6:00 PM.
- The fishing tournament starts at 6:00 AM on Saturday, July 20, 2024.
- All team members must be in line for weigh-in by 4:00 PM. The line opens at 1:00 PM.
- Teams consist of a maximum of 5 members and 1 boat. Random polygraph tests will be given to winners. False entries will disqualify the entire team. Picture ID is required for claiming cash prizes.
- Professional guides and licensed captains are eligible to participate but must pay entries. Wade fishing is allowed. Team members cannot fish from more than one boat.



Rules & Information continued:

- Fish must be caught by the person weighing in for the optional team pot. All participants are subject to polygraph tests. Only rod and reel may be used.
- Redfish must be 20-28 inches; Speckled Trout must be 15-20 inches. Flounder must be 15 inches or longer.
- Individual fish & optional team stringer can only be weighed once.
- There are four payout categories:
 - 1st place – 3rd place: Heaviest Trout
 - 1st place – 3rd place: Heaviest Redfish
 - 1st place – 3rd place: Heaviest Flounder
 - 1st place – 3rd place: Optional Team Pot (Stringer). 30% of the Optional Team Pot goes to the CCAPI Scholarship Fund. The heaviest 3-fish Stringer Fish weighed for the team stringer are NOT Eligible for individual payout pools. If no 3-fish stringers are weighed, the heaviest stringer of one trout and one redfish wins. Decide which category to weigh your fish in before approaching the weigh master.
- All Texas Parks and Wildlife rules apply and will be strictly enforced. Violators will be disqualified.
